COLORGUARD APPLICATION INFO PACKET 2010-2011

Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in being a member of the Berkmar High School Colorguard. The season will run from May 2010 through April 2011. We will perform at all the football games, several marching competitions, local and national parades, and take many trips with the marching band. Involvement in this activity requires dedication and hard work. All parents need to participate with the Berkmar Band Boosters.

To tryout, you must complete the attached application and subsequent forms in their entirety and return them to Mr. Wiebers on the first day of tryouts. Tryout practices are mandatory!!! Please come prepared wearing shorts/comfortable pants (no jeans), a t-shirt, and tennis shoes. We will be outside! All school rules for clothing and attire apply at all times.

Tryouts will be held on **Saturday, May 15th AND Saturday, May 22nd from 11:00 am to 3:00 PM at Berkmar High School in the band room.**

Please bring plenty of water, sunscreen, all your forms and *\$5 each day for lunch or bring your own lunch from home*. A required physical form must be on file with the Berkmar Band Director for all colorguard members for 2010-2011 by July, 2010.

There will be band/colorguard dues. These are fees that all students participating in marching band pay in order to cover the cost of transportation, instruction, equipment, festival and competition registration fees, and much more. Dues this year will be \$250 plus the cost of your uniform. The uniform will be your property and remain yours after each year. Uniforms are estimated at \$95 plus the cost of shoes at \$35 for a total of \$130. All dues and fees can be paid in installments and are always off-set with fund-raisers so you never need to pay out of pocket. Dues are nonrefundable, so please be sure you are dedicated and committed to being a part of the team. All dues and fees must be paid according the payment schedule and must be paid in full by December of 2010.

All colorguard members are required to also attend our summer band camps. The fees for band camp must be paid in full prior to the beginning of the camps. The estimated cost for camp this year is \$340 or less. These fees cover a week long mandatory camp for all marching band and colorguard members away from home. The dates for camp this year are included in this packet and all members are required to attend as this is where we will learn our half-time show performance and have an awesome time meeting new friends.

Finally, there will be a mandatory meeting on June 10th at 7:00 PM in the band room that all parents and students are required to attend.



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Welcome to the Berkmar High School Band Program!

This is a brief summary of our band program. A more detailed Berkmar High School Patriot Band Handbook will be distributed to all members later this summer.

The Berkmar High School Band program includes:

Marching Band • Symphonic Band • Concert Band • Jazz Ensembles • Pep Band • Colorguard and Winter Guard • Percussion Ensemble and Indoor Drumline • Small Chamber Groups • Music Technology

For all band programs, participation in after school rehearsals and performances is required.

The Berkmar High School Band Booster Association (Band Boosters) is comprised of active band members, colorguard members, their parents or guardians and other persons interested in supporting the band program at Berkmar High School. Band Boosters is a parent - volunteer run, 501(c)3 non-profit organization. Booster meetings are scheduled monthly.

The Berkmar Band is family oriented in that active participation by band students, their parents, guardians and families is vital to sustain and improve the program.

All band students and their parents/guardians are expected to pay band fees and dues. Fund-raisers are always available to assist students in earning money for dues. Participation by all members in all fund-raising events and band activities is mandatory.

Berkmar Marching Patriot Corps – is our primary performing organization during the fall. All band students who wish to attend band trips and take part in advanced band and/or jazz band must be apart of the marching band. All students are capable and expected to be in the Marching Patriot Corps. The Marching Patriot Corps performs half-time shows at football games during the Fall semester, performs three weekend marching competitions in the Fall and other occasional parades or performances throughout the year. Some activities, rehearsals and performances also continue into the Spring semester.

Colorguard – is the most vital part of the Marching Patriot Corps. The flags, swords, props, drama, live action, and all around performance from the Colorguard provides that needed atmosphere that brings our half-time show and other performances to life. The Colorguard takes place during the fall, spring, and summer each year and requires a lot of dedication and determination as a member. They perform at all football games, the Gwinnett County Marching Exhibition, three to four Competitions from September through October, parade performances in Atlanta and Lilburn, GA and attend all out of state band trips.

Important Dates:

May 15th – Tryout day 1 in Berkmar High School Band Room 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

May 22nd – Tryout day 2 in Berkmar High School Band Room 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

June 3rd – All Signed forms and \$30 Dues Deposit are due at Rookie Camp.

June 3rd and 4th - Rookie Camp – All Colorguard Members must attend 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM each day. These two days are the final tryout days for colorguard members
It is a mandatory instructional day camp for all new Marching Band and Colorguard members including rising 9th graders. It will be held at Berkmar High School. The emphasis will be on basic marching and playing skills. 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM - cost is \$5 per day for lunch or students may bring their own.

June 10th – Mandatory Band Meeting for ALL band and colorguard parents and members, not just marching band. 7:00 PM in the BHS Band Room 6.201

July 15th – 16th - Band Pre-Camp - mandatory for all students participating in Marching Band and Colorguard before heading off to camp. 9:30AM - 3:30PM Cost is \$5 per day for lunch or students may bring their own.

July 18th - 23rd - BAND CAMP – A mandatory week-long instructional band camp for all Marching Band and Colorguard members including rising 9th graders

July 26th – 30th – BAND HOME CAMP – Our final mandatory week-long camp for all marching band and Colorguard members held at BHS much like our rookie camp. It is held from 9:30-3:30 each day in order to finish learning drill and music from the show not accomplished at camp the week before. Cost is \$5 a day for lunch or students may bring their own.

Dues, Fees, and Fund-raisers

BAND CAMP 2010

Note about band camp 2010 - Due to circumstances beyond our control at North Georgia Technical College, we will NOT be having our annual band camp at this college any longer. The living conditions and facilities have become insufficient and too costly for our needs. We are currently looking for a new place for camp and will know by the June 10th mandatory meeting. The following estimate is based on information we have obtained from perspective colleges and camps. We WILL still have band camp July 18-23.

Band Camp Fees: **\$340.00 ***

This fee covers all meals, lodging for the week, transportation, tubing trip, percussion, colorguard and band instructor costs plus other costs for the Marching Band Camp outlined in our budget on June 10, 2010.

The following are fee estimates based on prior years costs. The final budget for the 2010-11 school year has not been finalized, but fees are expected to be the same as last year. Finalized dues will be provided at the Mandatory June 10th Booster Meeting at 7:00PM.

*Full payment of Band Camp fees will be required *prior* to the start of Band Camp in July. A payment schedule with installment payment deadlines between now and July is available.

Colorguard Member Dues: (Your student will fall into one of the following categories.)

All Colorguard 1st Student **\$250.00 *** Includes event transportation, equipment, instruction, etc.

All Colorguard Siblings **\$200.00 *** Includes event transportation, equipment, instruction, etc.

*A payment schedule for Band/Colorguard Member Dues with installment payment deadlines will be provided. We anticipate the final installment deadline for Dues will be in December 2010. Plenty of fund-raisers are made available throughout the year so all students may not have to pay any out-of-pocket expense as long as they fully participate.

SPRING TRIP 2011 – These fees for this trip have not been set and are estimated only based on the rates of gas, hotels, and previous trips taken by the band and other organizations at BHS. We are still looking into a place to hold our spring trip, but would like to do a quick three day trip to Universal Studios in Orlando, FL

The estimated trip fees for spring 2011 are **\$400.00** for two nights, transportation, events and registrations, all accommodations and meals, equipment transportation, and entrance fees while in Orlando.

Deposits for the annual band trips are due in SEPTEMBER of each school year at \$100 with no exception and are non-refundable.

Each payment for dues and trip fees MUST be paid in full and on time in order to attend the trip. Band fund-raisers are always made to help off-set the cost of the fees/dues and there are plenty of opportunities available so a student and parent NEVER have to pay for anything out of pocket. It is the Band Booster Association and Band Directors personal goal to make sure every student regardless of income, gender, religion, or race has the privilege and ability to attend any band function so long as the student and parent participates and successfully demonstrates a willingness to take care of their obligations to the band program.

Personal Costs:

Colorguard personal uniform accessories: **Uniform, Marching/Dance Shoes, Accessories, & hat ~ \$140.00**

These items are the student's property to keep and maintain throughout their high school career for 4 years and can be renewed independently if the items are worn out. Uniforms will change design yearly per show theme.

The Colorguard Uniform is replaced every year due to the theme of the half-time show and must be purchased each year. Pricing is determined each year and the lowest cost possible will be found to make sure all can participate.

Fund-raisers:

One of the most important functions of the Band Boosters is to provide supplemental funding for the purchase, maintenance and repair of instruments, colorguard equipment and instruction, travel expenses, music needed supplies, rental trucks for moving equipment, competition registration fees, music purchase for the year, private instruction, uniform cleanings and alterations along with other services necessary to operate our band program through the Boosters.

Fund-raisers for 2009-2010 included: Discount Card sales, concession stand sales, Taste of Berkmar Jazz Coupons, Booklet Ads, Candy Sales, the Annual Fruit Sale in November, Tastefully Simple on-line sales, Bowl-a-thon in the Fall and Spring, BHS Garage Sale, Krispy Kreme Donuts Sales, and more.

Profit from home football game concessions will be applied to the Band's general account. Parents are expected to work or chaperone at least one of the scheduled games in 2010 as we have an awesome new football schedule and need the help!.

Please Note: Family participation in fund-raisers is mandatory for each year.

Fund-raisers will be designed so that a percentage of profits will apply as future credits toward an individual's band member student account.

***Fund-raisers and Band/Colorguard Dues will be set at the monthly band booster meeting in June to determine the budget for the 2010-2011 school year. This meeting is to set the actual cost of band dues and appropriate percentages of fund-raiser disbursements that will be determined as well as address all band rules and procedures.**



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Berkmar Band/Colorguard Commitment Form 2010 - 2011

The following provides information about membership in the Berkmar Band. One copy of this form must be signed by both student and parents and returned to your band director by May 15th. Please keep a copy for your records.

Colorguard Dues:

Marching Band/Colorguard Dues may be paid over a seven-month period from May to December, according to the Dues Payment Schedule. The extension of payments over seven months makes participation as affordable as possible for all interested students. Fund-raisers will be scheduled to coincide with scheduled dues payment dates to assist students with making those scheduled payments.

Payment of Dues also includes the student's participation in Colorguard, Advanced or Concert Band, Jazz Band and Pep Band and for all band classes both the fall and spring semesters.

Dues help to supply our students with numerous needs throughout the school year including supplemental instruction, uniform rental and maintenance, colorguard equipment, equipment transportation, contest entry fees, marching drill, support equipment, props, private instruction, website management, office and mailing supplies, etc. Band dues are to supply funds for our programs that are not supplied by the state and county governments or local school supplements.

Dues for students in Marching Band/Colorguard for the 2010-2011 year are \$250 per student (Siblings \$200). Again, payments can be extended from May to December. ***That's less than \$36 a month!***

Each year the Band Booster Executive Board sets a budget which is presented for approval at the June Band Booster meeting. The following Dues Payment Schedule will be presented at that time. Major changes to the Dues Payment Schedule are not anticipated.

Dues Payment Schedule for Marching Band – 2010-2011

- June 3rd - **\$30 Dues Deposit due at Rookie Camp and Colorguard Auditions.**
- July 17th - **\$340 non-refundable payment prior to Band Camp: July 18th – July 23rd.**
- August 26th - **\$70 Dues Payment - August Candy Sale: 100% profit to student accounts.**
- October 28th - **\$75 Dues Payment – Fund-raiser TBA**
- November 11th - **\$75 Dues Payment – Fruit Sale Fund-raiser**

Other Expenses:

- Depending on budgetary needs, supplemental dues may be charged to students who also choose to participate in additional ensembles such as Jazz Band, Winter Colorguard, Pep Band, or Indoor Percussion. These groups typically perform after marching season and in the spring semester. Costs have averaged around \$40 per year.
- Students who use school supplied instruments will be assessed a \$30 maintenance fee per semester. This fee is mandated by GCPS. A limited number of instruments are available.
- Individual expenses for meals and personal items such as T-shirts, Polo Shirts, gloves and shoes will be charged as necessary. Individual participation in select events such as District Honor Band, All-State Honor Band, UGA Jan Fest, etc. may result in additional expense as well.
- The Marching Band attends an out of state competition every other year. The Spring 2010 trip was to Washington D.C. We are attempting this year to start doing a trip every year like our chorus and orchestra programs. Participation in the Spring 2011 trip is **strongly suggested** that all advanced band and marching band/colorguard students attend. The costs associated with these trips vary and are in addition to normal Band Dues. Our next out of state competition is for Spring 2011 and is estimated at \$400.00. ***98-100% of the Marching Patriot Corps MUST attend and participate in the trips. Otherwise, due to instrumentation and costs we cannot attend and will forfeit all deposits. PLEASE PAY ON TIME AND IN FULL.***

The primary focus of fund-raisers is to help students raise money for their individual dues accounts and to assist Band Boosters in raising money for general operational needs and future costs of our band programs. Specific details about individual fund-raisers will be provided as the time for the fund-raiser approaches.

Fund-raisers for 2009-2010 included: Discount Card sales, concession stand sales, Taste of Berkmar Jazz Coupons, Booklet Ads, Candy Sales, the Annual Fruit Sale in November, Tastefully Simple on-line sales, Bowl-a-thon in the Fall and Spring, BHS Garage Sale, Krispy Kreme Donuts Sales, and more.

Profit from home football game concessions will be applied to the Band's general account. Parents are expected to work or chaperone at least one of the scheduled games in 2010.

Family / Parent Commitment:

The success of any band program is largely dependent on the level of parental participation. Our band program and band budget are based on the premise that *every* band family will participate to the extent it can and will pay Band Dues according to the Dues Payment Schedule. Many volunteer opportunities are available to parents including working as chaperones, pit and equipment crew, concession workers, Executive Board and Committee memberships, etc. Please support your student by participating as an active band booster. Your student needs and deserves your support and you will have a fun time working with some wonderful people. These positions are open to ALL band parents regardless of marching band participation.

Consequences for Non-Payment of Dues or for Not Participating in Fund-raisers:

The consequences for not participating in fund-raisers or not paying Band Dues by the scheduled deadlines include, but are not limited to the following:

- Suspension from performances.
- Loss of eligibility to earn a Band/Colorguard Letter.
- Ineligibility for Band Booster funded trophies and awards at the annual band banquet.
- Suspension from Band Booster funded events, including the band banquet and spring trips.
- Loss of eligibility to participate in future Band Booster funded or facilitated trips and events.
- Suspension or dismissal from the Marching Band/Colorguard or Concert Band program.
- Loss of eligibility to attend school functions such as Prom, Plays, Dances, Field Trips, etc.
- A student's grades may be withheld in the event a non-payment status is prolonged.
- Senior students may be held from the Graduation Ceremony and denied a diploma.
- If a student should withdrawal from the band program at any point, all dues and fees currently owed by the student are due immediately in full or grades and graduation may be withheld.

There is no intent to exclude any student based on a legitimate financial need. The payment of Dues has been extended from May to December to make participation as affordable as possible and to assist those who may need additional time to pay their Band Dues. Any Band student who makes a commitment to the Berkmar High School Band program and later finds that he or she cannot honor their financial commitment because of a family financial crisis or other exceptional circumstance *must immediately bring their situation to the attention of the Band Director and Band Booster Treasurer.* In those circumstances, special arrangements will be offered including extended payment plans, additional fund-raising opportunities, and work-equity opportunities. *Non-payment of Band Dues is not an option.* Your communication with the band director and band booster board is required in order for us to maintain a well run superior program.
